

OVERHEAD 6: REFLECTOR'S FEEDBACK GUIDELINES**1. Ask the supervisor:**

What went well in each of the steps?

What needs improvement?

What would you do differently next time?

2. Ask the teacher:

What do you feel the supervisor did effectively?

What areas do you feel need improvement?

What suggestions do you have for future interactions?

3. Offer your reflections:

Summarize what you heard specifically in each step.

Offer your reflections on what went well.

Provide your suggestions or alternatives.

4. Conclusion of feedback process:

Summarize key points of the feedback process.

Ask the supervisor for questions or comments.

Give your written reflections to supervisor.

OVERHEAD 7: DIRECTIVE INFORMATIONAL APPROACH**KEYS STEPS—DIRECTIVE INFORMATIONAL APPROACH**

1. Identify the problem or goal and solicit clarifying information.

2. Offer solutions. Ask for the teacher's input into the alternatives offered and request additional ideas.

3. Summarize chosen alternatives, ask for confirmation, and request that the teacher restate final choices.

4. Set a follow-up plan and meeting.
